Dear Friends in Christ,

O N ALL SAINTS DAY, POPE Leo XIV named Saint John Henry Newman Co-Patron of Catholic Education. At one point or another in his life, Cardinal Newman was involved in every level of Catholic education – from the schoolboys at his Birmingham Oratory to the University of Dublin.

Newman understood that Catholic education comes down to this: *to form children not just for this world but for the next*. We want them to be well-educated but also – and more importantly – formed in the virtues of Christ. As Pope Leo XIV said, Jesus Christ Himself is “the Educator par excellence. We are his disciples

and are in his ‘school.’ We learn how to discover in his life, namely in the path he has travelled, a horizon of meaning capable of shining a light on all forms of knowledge. May our schools and universities always be places of listening to the Gospel and putting it into practice... I pray that Catholic education will help each person to discover their own call to holiness.”

Now, that’s a good summary of what we want to accomplish and what we pray for the children at Saint James School.
